### Reguests to the publication

- 1. The theses of the reports should be printed in English (no more than 1 page) and transmitted by email to organizing committee.
- 2. The theses should be collected on the computer in the Word for Windows (.rtf file format, supported MS Word 6.0 & 7.0).
- 3. The theses should be printed on a paper of the A4 format.

Fields: left - 2,5 cm, right, upper and lower - 1,5 cm.

4. The report is collected font type "Aryal Cyr".

The title of report (bold, size 14, all characters - capital, without word-wrapping) prints at the top of list.

Surname and initials of the writers (plain, size 12) are printed with new strings. Further on following string-organization, city, country (plain, size 12), and arrange on center.
